Order Of Service

HYMN COPYRIGHT - There are a number of copyright issues in relation to reproducing hymns that you must be aware of when choosing your hymns.

If the writer of a hymn has been dead for over 70 years the hymn is in public domain and is copyright free. In this case all that is required is the hymn name, the writer's name and his/her birth and death date.

However, if the writer has not been dead for over 70 years the hymn is still in copyright and so permission is required to reproduce the hymn. If the church where your wedding is taking place has a Christian Copyright License (CCL) then you must obtain the licence number from the church and check to see if the hymn is covered by the CCL. The Church must then report on the hymn(s) being reproduced and so a copy of the order of service booklet must be left with the church for their records. The church CCL number must then be printed alongside the relevant hymn in your order of service booklet.

It is your responsibility to obtain all permissions for hymns and other music you wish to print.
